<p>Description <i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i></p>			
<p>In this work package we essentially had three major working moments: a) fortnightly meetings between the partners, from January to April 2023, and then monthly, between April and July 2023; b) local meetings, between the partners and the participants from each country in work package 1, a minimum of seven local meetings per country (or in the case of Cais 1515 eleven local meetings); transnational meeting between all the partners and their participants.</p> <p>From these working moments, we developed several results (which can be consulted on the project website), namely: a national report per country, with a minimum of 10 pages each; a fact sheet with the data that partners and their participants found most relevant; a transnational report, the result of the local work and the transnational meeting that took place in July; and an extra report, developed exclusively by the participants, with the supervision of mentors from each partner organization.</p> <p>All this work was produced by 76 young people, aged between 18 and 30, and with the tireless help of the heads of each organization, pedagogical trainers, teachers of the official languages of each country, history teachers and other stakeholders, such as municipal entities in each country, local libraries and, of course, some moments from civil society in each country.</p> <p>Together, these young people took an important step with Work Package 1, to make their first discoveries about the dictatorships that prevailed in their countries and about the artistic resistance movements that, in some way, helped to overthrow those regimes, give a voice to the oppressed and give hope to the disillusioned. Above all, they discovered, through the arts and active citizenship, how democracies and freedom were built in Portugal, Spain, Italy, and Germany. During these discoveries, we came to understand the importance of the European Union and how important the union of our countries has been in creating synergies to make freedom a pillar that everyone wants to be unshakeable today.</p> <p>After work package 1, these young people realized that today, we are threatened by political forces that want to return to other times, which we don't want back, for the sake of democracy and freedom. Above all, we began to realize that autocratic regimes are part of history, but if we are not active participants, attentive, with love for others, we can easily go back to living history that is not so far in the past, but which seems to be getting forgotten these days.</p> <p>By the 24th of September we have counted 1777 people who had interacted with the resources from the page https://poetryofresistance.cais1515.pt/research-and-reflect/ and downloaded, at least, one of the articles.</p>
